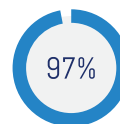

WHAT MATTERED MOST

INDEPENDENT LIVING

A contemporary, low-maintenance lifestyle

- Units should feel **contemporary, practical and financially realistic**.
- People wanted to be close to family and friends, with a low-maintenance lifestyle and access to home care and social supports.
- Having a connection to community and Jewish heritage matters to many.
- People wanted amenities such as a coffee shop, medical services, a gym, and a clubhouse or hobby area.
- The strongest interest is in **two-bedroom units**, with some interest in one and three-bedroom homes. **Choice** is a key takeaway.

RESIDENTIAL CARE

Quality care, Jewish life and connection

- Interest remains strong, with **quality care, Jewish life and community connection** consistently highlighted as priorities.
- The community emphasised a compassionate, high-quality care environment.
- Retaining connections to people, families and their Judaism was important.
- People want **larger rooms**, especially with separate living areas and a kitchenette.
- Access to courtyards, gardens and hair and beauty services mattered – plus cultural, fitness and Kosher options, and a library.
